Seattle University School of Law's alumni board, LAB, is seeking new members to join the Board for the 2018 - 2021 term.

The mission of the Law Alumni Board (LAB) is to protect and enhance the strength of Seattle University School of Law's academic and professional development programs, to promote and extend the positive profile of the School of Law, to support students and alumni in achieving their professional goals, and to ensure the fulfillment of the School of Law's mission to educate powerful advocates for justice. Please note: the selection process for LAB is highly competitive as the law school has many accomplished and qualified law graduates interested in joining the board.

The LAB is an active, working board and meets at least four times per year with each LAB member serving three-year terms, renewable consecutively only once. Every member of LAB serves on one or more of the following committees: Development, Mentoring and Professional Development, Outreach, Regional & South Sound, and Strategic Planning.

Members of LAB:

- Assist the School of Law in maintaining a positive image among alumni communities, the profession, and associations and institutions which are served by or interact with the School of Law;
- Provide support to the Office of Advancement and the dean regarding programs and initiatives of interest and value to alumni;
- Lead and set an example by making an annual gift. If able, we ask LAB members to make a minimum annual gift at the Dean's Club level (\$1,000) or Emerging Leaders level (\$100 for each year since graduation). Exceptions may be requested.
- Foster lifelong identification with the School of Law among its alumni to encourage and facilitate the continuing involvement of alumni in the affairs of the School of Law;
- Sponsor events where alumni and friends of the School of Law have opportunities to explore current issues relating to the School's academic programs;
- Assist the School of Law in educating legislators and other public officials as to the School's interests and needs in the public policy arena;

- Encourage the enrollment of qualified students and assist students with mentorship and networking;
- Recognize excellence and professional achievement among alumni; and
- Serve as a continuing liaison and channel of communication between the School of Law and its alumni.

- Invitations to Dean's Club events and to the annual President's Club recognition event

- Inclusion on the Dean's Club plaque, updated annually, mounted at the west entrance of Sullivan Hall, outside the Justice Fred H. Dore Courtroom
