The Policy Director will support the Chief Defender and First Assistant by overseeing the Policy Unit to provide qualitative and quantitative analysis relating to the operations, policies, programs, and practices of the Defender Association. The Director will work with criminal justice stakeholders to improve system outcomes for clients; create and oversee new programs designed to improve institutional and client outcomes; support a data-driven approach to evaluating the Association's performance; and oversee the analytical and data foundations for policy reports and recommendations. The Policy Director will serve a five-year term.
