Announcing the Judicial Fellows Clinic March 13-14, 2022 Seattle University School of Law

THE JUDICIAL FELLOWS CLINIC

Fellows will participate in a two-day interactive course, taught by instructors that are judges, MBA judicial evaluation committee members, and appointing authorities. Presenters will address topics including judicial ethics, the judicial appointment process, and preparing for a judicial campaign. In addition, Fellows will be assigned judicial mentors who will provide one-on-one feedback and guidance. At the end of the program, Fellows should have the skills and information to begin seeking a position on the bench. Fellows will also receive general and ethics CLE credits.

WHEN & WHERE

The next Judicial Fellows Clinic is scheduled for **March 13 and March 14, 2022** at Seattle University Law School. Fellows invited to attend are guests on campus and will need to follow Seattle University Law School Covid-19 public health precaution policies. In addition, the Judicial Institute may choose to postpone the clinic or conduct the clinic virtually due to COVID-19.
