EMPLOYER REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

OCI is managed through our [Simplicity](#) system. **If you do not have an account**, visit [Simplicity](#), click on “Employer” and choose the Sign-Up option on the right side of the screen. It may take several business days for your account to get approved by the Center for Professional Development (CPD).

To register for OCI, you must first log into [Simplicity](#). Once you log in, click on the “OCI” tab on the left side of the page. Then, click on the “**Schedule Request**” tab, followed by the “**Request A Schedule**” button. Please complete the **Schedule Request Form** for the appropriate session and click “**Submit**.” Please note that our OCI programming will support both in-person and virtual interviews. Requests will be reviewed in the order in which they are received, and you will be contacted with confirmation accordingly.

If you would like us to collect resumes for your firm so you can schedule interviews yourself, please complete the **Schedule Request Form**, per above, and select “**Resume Collect**” rather than “**Interview**.”
