2026 Seattle University School of Law Scholarship Sponsored by Washington Women Lawyers, King County Chapter

Scholarship: The King County Chapter of Washington Women Lawyers (KCWWL) is pleased to provide a **\$2,000.00** scholarship to one second-year law student who identifies as female at the Seattle University School of Law. Part-time/Flex and non-JD students are also eligible if their number of credits is roughly equivalent to that of a second-year law student. The scholarship is intended to promote individualism and courage within the profession and support women who have the potential to make a significant contribution to the community and/or have demonstrated an ability to overcome significant obstacles in their lives.

Requirements:

- Candidates must be second-year law students (part-time/Flex and non-JD students are also eligible if their number of credits earned is roughly equivalent to that of a second-year law student) who identify as female.
- The recipient must also be a student member of KCWWL. Membership is free and valid for one year. Please see our [Membership Registration](#) page for more information on how to become a member.

Application Materials: Please submit the following via email to the KCWWL Scholarship Chair at kcwvlscholarship@gmail.com:

- Your resumé (including student group/professional memberships and any board/leadership positions or significant contributions; work experience; and volunteer experience);
- Your law school transcript (unofficial is acceptable); and
- A written statement (12-point font, double-spaced, no more than two pages) explaining how to promote the leadership and/or inclusivity of women in the legal profession. Please include examples.
- (Optional) If there are any important considerations or circumstances you wish to share that would help us to best assess your application (e.g., hardships, family commitments, financial obstacles), you may do so in a one-page addendum.

Deadline: Please submit your application materials ***no later than 11:59PM, October 10, 2026***. Scholarship recipients will be notified by November 2026. Please direct any questions to kcwvlscholarship@gmail.com.
